Terms of Business

Deposit

All deposit payments are required 48 hours prior to arranged Funeral Service.

A minimum deposit of £1,000.00 is required for any arranged cremation service or burial where the grave has already been purchased.

A minimum deposit of £1,500.00 is required for any arranged burial with grave purchase.

If the Funeral Director is required to pay the authorities a 'non-resident fee' for a grave purchase on behalf of their client, the cost will be added to the required deposit.

Invoice

The client will receive the final invoice within 5 days following the arranged funeral service. Full payment of the 'Final Invoice' will be due within 30 days of the invoice date. If the client has any concerns regarding the final invoice including an issue meeting these terms, then we request to be informed prior to the end of the 30th day.

If full payment is not received by WS. Taylor & Sons Limited by the due date, the client will receive a postal reminder of the outstanding invoice and be given 7 days to make payment with no action. Thereafter if no payment has been received, the company may charge interest to the client. The interest charged is at a rate of 2% per year (of the outstanding balance) above the base lending rate of the Bank of England. The interest will accrue on daily basis from the invoice due date until the final day that the outstanding balance is paid in full, whether before or after judgement. Should matters escalate further, i.e to court action, debt collection agencies or solicitors, all court fees/recoverable costs, interest charges and enforcement costs will be added to the final balance therefore the client will be liable. The prescribed court fees are set by The Ministry of Justice and can vary through time.

A full copy of the terms of business for WS Taylor & Sons Ltd can be issued on request. The client will always receive a copy at the time of arrangement from the Funeral Director and be asked to sign to accept responsibility of payment.
